D. PUBLIC COMMENTS.

Council thanked Waverly Light and Power for their prompt attention to outages over the weekend during the ice storm. Waverly Light and Power is asking heavy users to minimize their power during ice storms.

Council also thanked City crews for their snow cleanup during the hazardous and heavy storm conditions over the weekend.

Public Services Superintendent Brian Sullivan informed Council a valve had frozen on a 400,000 gallon sludge tank and it was leaking. Mr. Sullivan stated he had talked to the DNR and that the leak is being contained. BMG, the sludge hauler hired by the City, will be here on Tuesday, February 27, 2007 to pick up sludge and dispose of it properly to landowners with land application permits required by the DNR. The valve on the 400,000 gallon sludge tank had not froze in the past.
