1. **Approval of Contract Between the City of Waverly and IBEW Local Union 288 (City Unit).**

D. STUDY SESSION.

1. **Review 2012 Goals of Waverly Sister City.**

Keith Collins of Waverly Sister City reviewed the history of Eisenach and Waverly relationship. He informed Council that Sister City members and the Waverly Municipal Band plan to travel to Eisenach in September. In October a delegation from Eisenach hopefully will visit Waverly to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Sister City. The Sister City Board is requesting additional funding of \$3,000 for expenses that will be incurred when the Eisenach delegation comes to Waverly.

2. **Review 2012 Goals of the Hazard Mitigation and River Use Commission.**

Chris Triplitt, Chair of the Hazard Mitigation and River Use Commission reviewed 2011 goals and accomplishments. The riverbank by the old AMVETS will be restored in the fall along with installation of water trail signs. The intent is to create a water trail from Plainfield to Janesville for kayaks and canoes. The Commission will also be studying the Dry Run Improvement project to protect adjacent property owners from flash flooding. The Commission will be working with staff to complete a Community Action Plan exercise. Mr. Triplitt stated that the Commission

will be collaborating with the new Upper Cedar Watershed Coalition to develop a 28E agreement.

3. **Review Water Tower Colors & Lettering.**

City Engineer Cherry reviewed the line-of-sight angles of each of the City's water towers. Staff recommends that all the towers should remain the same color and should have the word "Waverly" and the WSR Go-Hawk symbol aligned with major roadways. Mr. Cherry offered examples of lettering and paint coloring. Staff will check on the cost of placing the City logo on said towers.
