A. Work Session Item:

The meeting of the Waverly City Council was held on October 1, 2012, at 4:00 p.m. in the Ivan "Ike" Ackerman Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Brunkhorst presided. 1. Discuss the candidates' qualifications and background for the City Administrator Position.

- Richard Fursman of Brimeyer-Fursman, LLC said there were 65 initial applicants which were narrowed down to 20. Once they reached the 20 applicants the firm narrowed the number of candidates to 12 presented profiles for 12 candidates.
- Mr. Fursman reviewed profiles for each of the 12 candidates.
- After review was complete Mayor and Council voted on their top 5 choices by writing the number of the candidate down and then Mr. Fursman tallied those and it was narrowed to 5 candidates with 1 alternate.
- There will be 5 candidates interviewed on Friday, October 12, 2012 and Saturday, October 13, 2012.
- There will be a chance for the public to meet and greet the 5 candidates at the Waverly Public Library on Friday, October 12, 2012 from 5:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.
