



reviewed the Iowa Governmental Health Care Plan renewal history, the positives and negatives to City employees and the City of Waverly. The overall liability to the City is decreased because plan design has lower out of pocket maximums than the current design. Last year this would have saved the City of Waverly \$19,860.00. Cobra and self-funded dental and vision can also carry over to the consolidated billing. Finance Director Bachhuber stated during discussions with different City employee groups and with Carolyn Rebel, he feels this action is positive to keep health care costs down. Ritchie Kurtenbach, IBEW 288 Union Representative, stated employees are open to said change in the health care plan. The Affordable Care Act will be an additional health insurance cost. The .06% rate increase would be from September 1, 2013 to 6-30-14. The City will receive the 2014 rate in January.

2. **First Reading of Ordinance 973, An Ordinance Amending the Zoning Ordinance of Waverly, Iowa Providing for Rezoning from A-1, (Agricultural District) and R-1,(Single Family Residential District) to C-2(Commercial District) of Said City for property at 1402 4<sup>th</sup> Street SW and three adjacent properties to the South From R-1, (Single Family Residential District) to Mixed Use on the Comprehensive Land Use Map.**

Community Development & Zoning Specialist Kohout informed Council the frontage road in front of the residential properties along 4<sup>th</sup> St. SW is not going to connect to the rezoned property. Council discussed a development agreement with residents and Convenient Store Inc. on lighting and sound barriers. Wade Dummond of Kwik Star and Convenience Store Investments, Inc. stated that Kwik Star automatically puts screening between residences and their businesses. All new stores have lighting filters to minimize inconvenience to adjacent properties. The Council also discussed cars exiting the Kwik Star onto 4<sup>th</sup> Street SW and screening for the golf course. The store should open mid to late summer of 2014.
