# 2. Presentation of Business Incubator Concept

Scott Fullwiler of Wartburg and Kelly Engelken of the Waverly Chamber of Commerce presented a Business Incubator Concept for Waverly and surrounding communities. This is not the typical incubator model, rather it is a process. The major difference is that instead of constructing a facility to host new business start-ups, the new business is housed within an existing business that donates space. The Waverly Area Development Fund is providing their 501(c)3 as an umbrella for the Incubator Program and the host company receives tax benefits for donating the space and utilities to the new business, due to the 501(c)3 status. The 8-step process serves to organize resources already available in the community and includes a market analysis, selection of entrepreneurs, training, bootstrapping, mentoring, finding an incubator, launching the business, and payback to the program.

Tim Ewest and Scott Fullwiler of Wartburg College have offered to commit their time toward this project for the first three years. Ongoing oversight of the project will need to be determined, along with other details of the program. Details are intentionally vague at this time, and the intention is to have a group of stakeholders help design the process.

The Commission perceived the process to be interesting and beneficial, based on the preliminary information presented, although they expressed a desire to learn of more detail when that becomes available.
