### 1. Discuss Highway 3/Bremer Avenue Reconstruction Project slated for 2017

the downtown owners would like done. After the forums, Toliver will put together a presentation to bring to Council. Toliver will bring in a firm to teach businesses how to stay open and succeed during the reconstruction project.

A public forum will take place on April 25<sup>th</sup> from 5pm – 7 pm, prior to the City Council Meeting.

2. Discuss plans for Join Economic Development Commission/City Council Meeting

Werger discussed the possibility of a joint Economic Development Commission and City Council meeting. Both groups were asked to complete a SWOT analysis for INRCOG. By having a joint meeting, both groups would be able to discuss the different aspects and views of the SWOT analysis.
