7. Description

This single-family house is estimated to have been built in 1865 according to Bremer County Assessor records. The house form and style are consistent with similar houses in Waverly built using this form from ca. 1875 to 1910. Property Transfer Records show Lots 6 and 7 in Fr. Block 2 held by Flora Allison (Allinson) and her husband George from April 1884 to April 1892 when it was sold to Eliza Laird. The Iowa Census for 1885 shows the Allison family residing on this property in 1885. Public records confirm a construction date of ca. 1884 rather than 1865.

This house is an example of a vernacular Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. The house has a parged stone foundation and the walls are clad in asbestos shingle or Transite® siding. The house has a very low-pitched hipped roof with narrow eaves and a wide cornice board. There are no dormers. A flat roofed enclosed porch spans most of the front façade. It has matching asbestos shingle siding on the balustrade and skirting areas with an entrance door centered between tall and narrow 1/1 windows that fill the upper walls. Windows on the main house are 4/4 double-hung units set beneath pedimented moldings. The window light size is evidence of the house's construction date of mid-1880s or slightly earlier.

The house has a 1-story detached single-bay garage constructed at the northwest corner of the house. It has a hipped roof, narrow wood clapboard siding, no corner board trim and is accessed from 1st St NW. According to the Assessor's records, the garage was constructed in 1965.

Alterations: asbestos siding, undated; porch enclosure, undated; foundation parging, undated.

8. Significance

The George and Flora Allison House was built in ca. 1884 or earlier and is an example of a vernacular Hipped Roof, 1-story house form. The house qualifies for the National Register of Historic Places as a contributing resource to the historic district under Criteria A and C.

Census records for 1885 show the Allison family residing on this parcel having purchased the property in Flora's name in April 1884. The household included three people in the Iowa Census of 1885 with George employed as a clerk, Flora keeping house, and Elizabeth Allison, age 78, as not employed. In April 1892, George and Flora sold the property to Eliza Laird, widow of Nathaniel Laird, who resided in southeast Waverly at the time. It is possible that she held the house as a rental property as was done by a number of women in Waverly.

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
