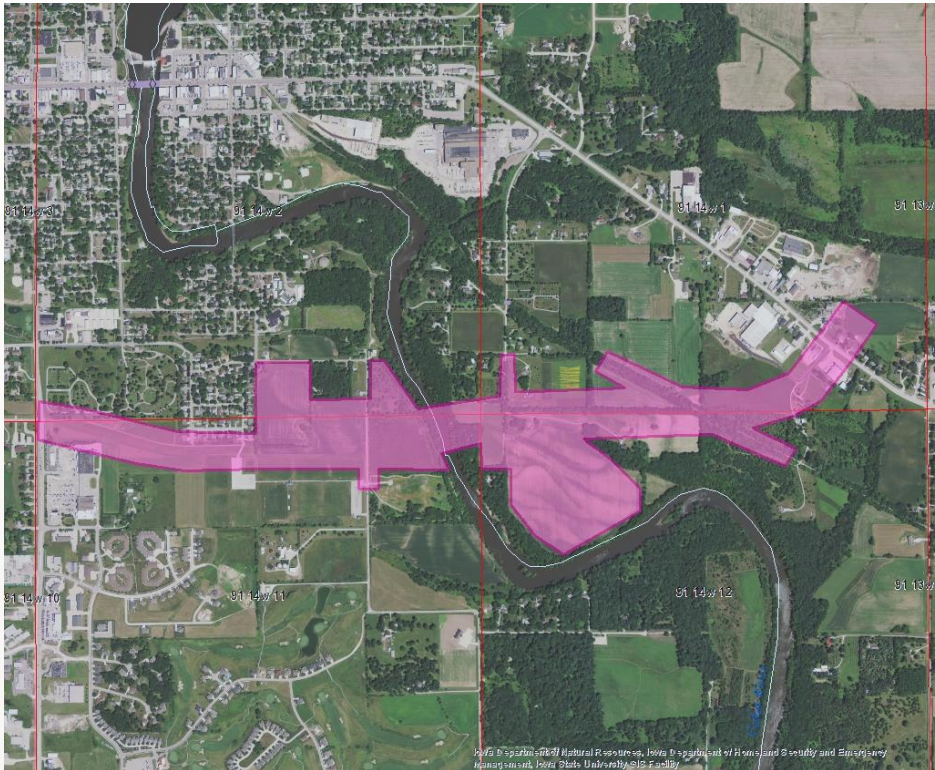

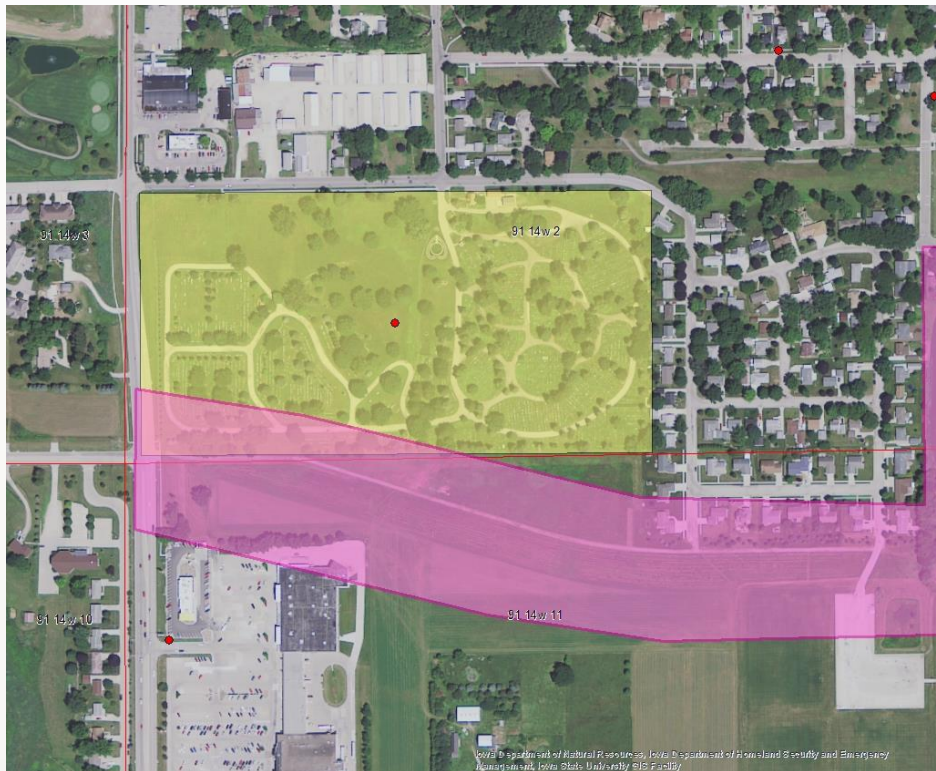

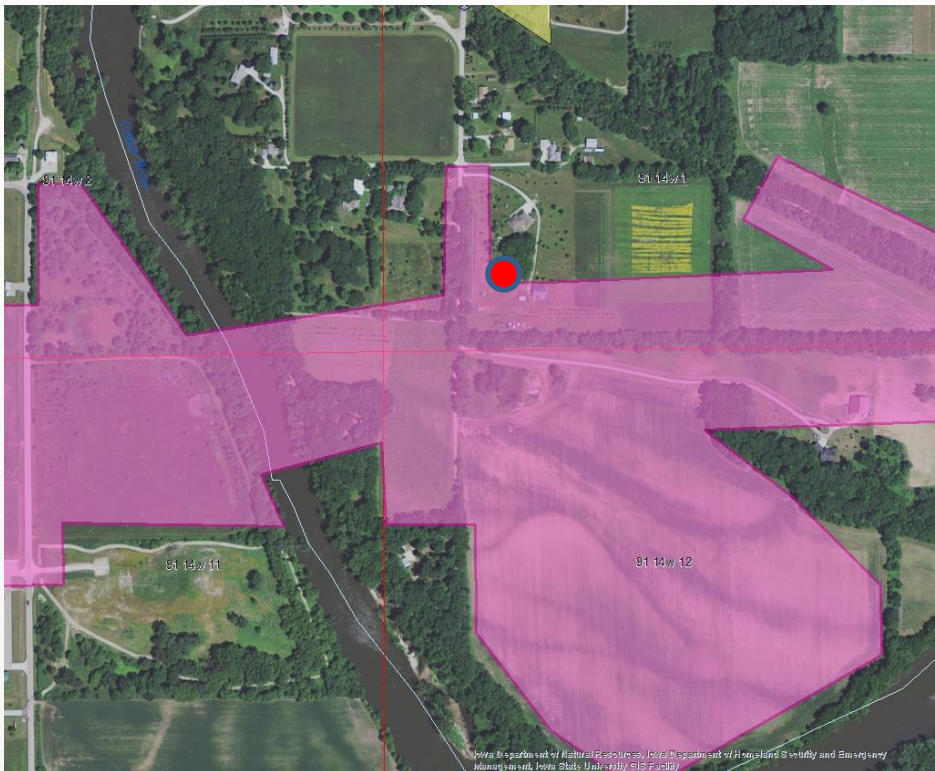

- Why was the property built? For what purpose?
- Who are the prominent families in the community who built or owned the property?
- What is significant about its structural and architectural style?

ABCs of 106 for CLGs

- Section 106 review for the 3rd Street SE Bridge in Waverly, IA
- Locally known as the “**Green Bridge**”
- History and Significance of the **Green Bridge**
- Placed on NRHP in 2017
- Built in 1916-17, Closed in 2015
- Now needs to be replaced
- Section 106 comes into play
