Mr. Ribich moved to approve the same slate of officers that currently hold offices (Hinderaker, Chairman, Boorum, Vice-Chairman, Hildebrandt, Secretary/Treasurer) this year, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Clemen. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Citizens Input

Mr. Kammeyer asked that the sheriff give consideration to allowing meals on wheels to contract with CBM for their meals. This is a result of what he has been advised as problems with the current providers. Sheriff was asked to contact Cindy Ecker about this.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented monthly bills. Mr. Boorum moved to pay 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Reuter. Carried.

Chairman Hinderaker set the next meeting for Monday, March 12, 2007 @ 0900.

Mr. Boorum moved to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Ribich. Carried.
