The Nobles Power Eagle 716 was presented for a purchase price of \$2,280 new and \$1,200 used. Mr. Reuter and Mr. Kammeyer both stated the board should check to see if the Law Center could get the one from the courthouse. The board decided to place the Carpet Extractor on the May 2007 agenda.

Chief Pursell presented monthly bills. Mr. Reuter motioned to pay bills with further description of Thermal Components, Generator repair and BLI Lighting, 2nd by Mr. Clemen. Description will be emailed to all board members by Treasurer. All present voted aye, motion carried.
