Mr. Reuter moved to authorize purchase 3 hard drives for \$615.00 plus shipping, 2nd by Mr. Clemen. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented monthly bills. Mr. Clemen moved to pay 2nd by Mr. Reuter. All present voted aye; motion carried.
