Chairman Hinderaker called the meeting to order at 0900 on Monday, April 13, 2009.

Mr. Ribich moved to approve the agenda, 2nd by Mr. Boorum. Carried

The minutes of the February meeting were reviewed. Mr. Boorum moved to approve, 2nd by Mr. Kammeyer. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented the treasurers report. Mr. Clemen moved to approve as presented, 2nd by Mr. Boorum. All present voted aye, motion carried.

Old Business

Chief Pursell reported that Waverly PW was working on grants that may assist with relocating the storage building.

New Business

Sheriff Hildebrandt advised the Board of the CodeRed test to county officials, all but two numbers connected successfully.

Sheriff Hildebrandt asked the board to consider purchasing Mobile Data Solutions from ShieldWare. This software and hardware would facilitate the placement of in squad computers throughout Bremer County and would utilize software already in place at the law center under the possession of the law board and from ShieldWare. Sheriff Hildebrandt and Chief Pursell discussed the many advantages of such a system to the police department, the sheriff office and any of the other communities throughout the county that might wish to participate. The cost of this system is \$36,500 including five licenses and each additional license would be at a cost of \$1,300.00 or higher if set by the board. (Each car computer requires one license and two are required in dispatch) The expense of the car computers and individual licenses would be left to the government body utilizing them. Essentially this places many of the capabilities of dispatchers within the squad cars enhancing officer safety and increasing productivity and accuracy. The board had many questions and asked Sheriff Hildebrandt to set up a demonstration by Shieldware representatives at our next meeting and to get further details to any other costs associated with such a system.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented a list of monthly bills. Mr. Kammeyer moved to pay bills as listed, 2nd by Mr. Ribich. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Chairman Hinderaker set the next meeting for Monday, May 11, 2009 @ 0900.

Mr. Boorum moved to adjourn, 2nd by Mr. Clemen. Carried.
