Quote sheet also included a Dell server for \$1,787.16 for a total project cost of \$45,287.16 with \$7,000.00 believed to be reimbursable through stimulus grant via a pass through from the city of Waverly making the grand total for the project to be \$38,287.16. Sheriff Hildebrandt further advised the board there will be an ongoing expense of 15% of the software costs for the project.

Mr. Ribich moved to authorize purchase Mobile Solutions at above cost, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Clemen. All present voted aye; motion carried.

**New Business**

Sheriff Hildebrandt advised the board that the DVR from Thermal Components is causing some problems and Thermal is suggesting since it is out of warranty that we consider upgrading it. Sheriff has not received a quote so this is information only at this time.

Sheriff Hildebrandt advised the parking lots are in need of painting and asked for direction. Mr. Boorum suggested Chief Pursell contact Brian Sullivan, city of Waverly and ask if they could do it while doing city line painting.

Sheriff Hildebrandt advised in order to potentially save energy and the cost of bulbs a timer could be placed on the sheriff's office lobby lights. Cost would be approximately \$300.00. Mr. Ribich moved to approve purchase, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Kammeyer. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented a list of monthly bills. Mr. Boorum moved to pay bills as listed, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Clemen. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Mr. Clemen moved to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Boorum. Carried.
