Chairman Hinderaker called the meeting to order at 0900 on Monday, April 12, 2010.

Mr. Boorum moved to approve the agenda, 2nd by Mr. Clemen. Carried.

The minutes of the March meeting were discussed. Mr. Clemen moved to approve, 2nd by Mr. Kammeyer. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented the treasurers report. Mr. Kammeyer moved to approve, 2nd by Mr. Boorum. All present voted aye, motion carried.

Old Business

There was no new development on storage building.

Chief Pursell reported on the CodeRed he placed on March 13, 2010. Chief Pursell submitted a full written report indicating a total of 10454 calls were made with 7,696 contacted. Due to the high volume of calls some calls were not received until after 45 minutes from the first call. Sheriff Hildebrandt and Chief Pursell advised the benefit to us for this call was to point out some of the shortcoming of this system such as the time it takes to place the call and the time it takes for the calls to be delivered when such a high volume is placed. Hildebrandt pointed out that it is important for citizens to not get so confident that CodeRed will be the answer to all their storm concerns and reminded that it is still very vital for people to listen to radio, tv and weather radios as a better source of immediate information. CodeRed is still offering to do an all call to help identify the capabilities of the phone systems and to determine "bad numbers" in our database which both should help speed up the call process. Board chose to not spend \$1,200 to \$1,500 to purchase the 911 database to do this test but the test will be done with existing database information.

New Business

Sheriff Hildebrandt requested that Thermal Components be allowed to install the new DVR during their upcoming PM which may save an additional trip expense. This is in next fy budget and Thermal has agreed to bill after July 1 if they can perform the install early to save them time and travel as well. Board consented to this request.

Sheriff Hildebrandt requested three four drawer file cabinets at a price of \$385.00 each for old case files. Mr. Boorum moved to purchase, 2nd by Mr. Clemen. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented a list of monthly bills. Mr. Clemen moved to pay bills as listed, 2nd by Mr. Kammeyer. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Mrs. Olson expressed a concern about meeting dates as they often conflict with her schedule. It was determined the date will remain the 2nd Monday of the month and she will phone conference when out of town.

Chairman Hinderaker set the next meeting for Monday, May 10, 2010 @ 0900.

Mr. Boorum moved to adjourn, 2nd by Mr. Clemen. Carried.
