Kip Ladage, Bremer County EMGT was present to discuss usage of CodeRed for summer storms. Ladage asked for clarification on what the criteria is for activating the calling system. Board discussed and questioned if CodeRed is being redundant to other notification methods used by NWS and existing outdoor warning systems. Sheriff Hildebrandt stated that often for summer storms time does not allow for pre-storm notifications and if that is the desire of the board consideration should be given to an automated system. Chief Pursell stated that he tells people that their first alerts will come from outdoor warning systems and NOAA and if time allows CodeRed may be used. Board asked Ladage to look into how automatic notifications could be restricted and report back at the next meeting.

Old Business

Mr. Crayne was unable to attend this meeting and will attend in July. Chief Pursell advised the board that he spelled out how he believed the board would like to approach an agreement with the city providing the land and the law board building and maintaining the building.

New Business

Sheriff Hildebrandt and Chief Pursell requested board permission to look into purchasing/leasing a color copy machine and if so to keep the existing machines and moving one into the intake area of the jail. Board consented and asked for proposal for the next meeting.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented a list of monthly bills to be paid. Mr. Neil moved to pay as presented, 2nd by Mr. Ranard. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Kammeyer set the next meeting for Monday, July 11, 2011 at 0900.
