Chairman Boorum called the meeting to order at 0900 on Monday, October 10, 2011.

Mr. Kammeyer moved to approve the agenda, 2nd by Mr. Neil. Carried.

The September minutes should reflect that Mr. Neil was absent and Mr. Reuter was his alternate. Mr. Kammeyer moved to approve the September minutes with that clarification, 2nd by Mrs. Olson. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented the treasurers report. Mr. Kammeyer moved to approve as presented, 2nd by Mr. Neil. All present voted aye; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt reported jail inmate numbers are down which is consistent with other jails as well. Mrs. Olson asked about articles in the Waverly Newspaper; lawsuit DeBower v. Bremer County and missing funds from jail room and board account. Chairman Boorum advised these are both Bremer County issues and thus would not be in the domain of this board. Mr. Kammeyer advised the DeBower v. Bremer County is being appealed and Sheriff Hildebrandt advised the missing funds from the jail involves an ongoing criminal investigation which would not allow further comment.

Old Business

Chief Pursell reported that the Waverly City Council authorized through resolution land at well site 7 for the purpose of erecting an evidence storage facility for the LEC. Chairman Boorum further advised that he reinforced that the existing agreement for the use of land would continue at this site as in place at the existing building site, that is no monies for rent or purchase would take place and a renewable 25 year agreement would be created. Board discussed grant possibilities to assist with this project. Chief Pursell was asked to request Mr. Cherry to do the necessary site survey work to determine where on the lot the building could sit and how water and sewer could be delivered to the building. Once this is determined Chief Pursell will ask the Board to put this out for bid.

Sheriff Hildebrandt refreshed the Board on the request for a color copier to replace the existing copier. Sheriff Hildebrandt advised that in the digital world the need for color photos is increasing for prosecution and defense as well as other investigatory purposes. A proposal from Advanced System and Mason City Business Systems was presented. Board asked Sheriff Hildebrandt to invite both companies to do a short presentation at the November meeting.
