Chairman Boorum called the meeting to order at 0900 on Monday, April 9, 2012.

Mr. Kammeyer moved to approve the agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Neil. Carried.

Mr. Kammeyer moved to approve the March minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Ranard. All ayes; motion carried.

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented the treasurers report. Mrs. Olson moved to approve as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Ranard. All ayes; motion carried.

**Old Business**

Storage Building: Specifications were discussed for erection of a 40' x 60' storage facility to be located on city property at well site number 7. Mr. Kammeyer stated he would prefer that an architect or a structural engineer develop the specs rather than relying on the qualifying builders submit their specs for approval. Sheriff Hildebrandt and Chief Pursell presented specs they felt were useful for a storage facility. Board suggested some revisions to what was submitted and asked that once completed the specs be sent to Bremer County Building and Zoning Administrator Doug Bird for his input/approval. **Mr. Neil moved to approve building specifications to be used for erection of the storage building contingent on approval of meeting building code by Mr. Bird, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Kammeyer. All present voted aye; motion carried.** Board advised Sheriff Hildebrandt once approved by Mr. Bird he should send them electronically to board for final ok to publish for competitive quotations.

Mr. Crayne was present for input on advantages of outdoor signs to publicize the fact that Local Option Sales Taxes were used for the building of the Bremer-Waverly Law Center and Jail. Mr. Neil stated he felt there should be one large temporary sign outside with a permanent sign placed in both the police and sheriff lobby. **Mr. Neil moved to have the Chief and Sheriff bring design options for LOST signs to the May meeting, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Kammeyer. All present voted aye; motion carried.**

**New Business**

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented an elevator inspection proposal from Rod Dierks. This proposal was to replace the annual state required inspection, Mr. Dierks proposal was for \$58.00 and we currently pay \$75.00. Board discussed the proposal. **Mr. Ranard moved to accept the two year elevator inspection proposal at a rate of \$58.00 subject to determining state certification of Mr. Dierks, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Neil. All present voted aye; motion carried.**

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented a list of monthly bills. **Mr. Kammeyer moved to pay as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mrs. Olson. All ayes; motion carried.**

Chairman Boorum set the next meeting for Monday, May 14, 2012 at 0900.
