Sheriff Hildebrandt requested board approval to replace two computer network switches at a cost of \$695.98 each. **Mrs. Olson moved to approve purchase of switches, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Kammeyer. All present aye; motion carried.**

Sheriff Hildebrandt presented a list of monthly bills. **Mr. Kammeyer moved to pay as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Ranard. All ayes; motion carried.**
