Tony and his wife Barb have lived in Waverly for almost 36 years. He retired from Wartburg College in May 2020, after 31 years. His wife Barb worked for Cuna Mutual for

36 years and now works remotely for F&G Life in Des Moines. Their son Erik lives in Clinton, IA and daughter Kjersten lives in Portland, OR. Tony and Barb both enjoy taking trips with their children and golfing along the way. One aspect of Tony's job as a Pro Shop Attendant is the

opportunity to talk with people who are playing the Waverly Golf Course for the first time or the first time in many years. He is looking forward to another busy year at the course!
