The park takes its name from the former large and widely known Willow Lawn Farm that one day occupied the land where the park currently sits. In 2007 the park was renamed Robert W. Ramker Willow Lawn Park after Robert Ramker the original developer of the addition and park land. The park features a play unit and swings that were installed in 2013, a basketball slab, extensive tree plantings and well-kept landscaping.
