Other amenities and activities include the Waverly Rail Trail, swimming pool, skate park, fishing, and boating on the Cedar River. There is also an Indoor swimming pool, public and private fitness centers, frisbee golf courses, skate park, sand volleyball courts, and camping areas at Cedar Bend Park.

Waverly also has two 18 hole award winning golf courses, one being owned by the City. A new amphitheater provides an outstanding venue for outdoor concerts.
