WAVERLY RECEIVES 2020 HEALTHY HOMETOWN COMMUNITY AWARD

The City of Waverly was presented with a 2020 Healthy Hometown SM Powered by Wellmark Community Award during the Iowa Healthiest State Initiative awards ceremony on Feb. 6, 2020. Along with recognizing the community for its health improvement initiatives, the award earns them the title of 2020 Healthy Waverly and \$5,000 to continue the important work of improving the physical, social and emotional well-being of the community.

Some noteworthy achievements in Waverly include:

- Traffic calming measures by reconfiguring Bremer Ave/Highway 3 from four lanes to three and added bump outs at various intersections.
- Adding raised garden beds and apple trees to the Community Sharing Gardens; produce is donated to local churches, social service groups and the Northeast Iowa Food Bank.
- Adopted a tobacco and nicotine free policy covering the 21 parks in Waverly and seven miles of trail system.

DOG PARK

As the weather gets better, the Waverly Bark Park will again be used by dog owners on a regular basis. This is the reminder that the park rules are in place to protect all users, canine and human.

- The most important rule is to have your dog immunized. The State of Iowa requires rabies and distemper shots for all dogs. We highly recommend Bordetella and a fecal screen on a regular basis. This will protect your dog as well as other users of the park.
- Dogs must be at least 4 months old to use the park. Dogs in heat should not use the park.
- Humans must be 8 years of age to enter the park and 15 years of age to bring a dog to the park. Dogs and younger children can't be supervised adequately at the same time. When in the facility, humans must control their dogs at all times.
- Owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Failure to do so could result in a fine and loss of the privilege to use the facility. Dog bags are available at the park or bring a grocery bag when you visit the park.
- Dog treats and human food should not be brought into the park. Give your dog a treat after the visit.

Safety is important to all users of the Waverly Bark Park, human and canine. Remember to have all your shots up to date, be of age to enter the dog park, and to always pick up after yourself.

Cemetery Flowers

According to the Harlington Cemetery Rules and Regulations, all winter decorations, holly, evergreen, or artificial wreaths that are not placed on concrete foundations or on flower stands must be removed by Wednesday, April 1, 2020.

All flowers left after this date will be removed and kept at the cemetery shop until Monday, April 13, 2020 and then discarded if not claimed.
