If there's something you need that is not listed here, please give us a call! We are more than happy to see what we can do to assist.

- Reference question assistance and help with online resources over the phone and through email.
- Outdoor return drops are open. Returned items are quarantined for three days before being checked in and returned to the shelf.
- Online collections and research databases are available 24/7 through our website. This includes Bridges, our largest collection of digital books, audiobooks, and magazines, as well as Kanopy, a new-to-us service that features movies and documentaries you can stream for free.
- Books and other items may be requested for drive-through pick up or free home delivery by calling (319) 352-1223 or emailing waverly@waverly.lib.ia.us with a maximum of 10 items.
- If you would like to request a drive-through pick up and don't know what you would like to read, we can provide recommendations, or you can pick one of our special bundles and let us pick for you!
- To-go kits containing crafts and other activities are available through the drive-through on a first come, first served basis. New kits are available every Monday for all ages, babies through teens.
- Summer Challenges are taking place online from June 8-July 17 through a program called Beanstack. These challenges are available for all ages, babies through adults.
- Computer access is available by appointment. Call in to reserve a one-hour time slot.
- Email simple documents to waverly@waverly.lib.ia.us to be printed and picked up through the drivethrough window. Bring documents to be photocopied to the drive-through window, and we can make copies for you.
- Browsing Hours for patrons to come into the building, browse the stacks, and check out materials will be available starting in early July. We are not taking appointments yet and are still working out the final details. More information will come soon.
