#### **NEW SELF-SERVICE OPTIONS**



In the last year, we have added several self-service options around the library. There are now two self-checkout stations available. One is near the front desk, and one is in the youth area. The public computers can now be logged onto by scanning your library card or a guest pass, and a new print release station helps keeps documents private and organized. You will still find

friendly librarians at the service desks who are happy to assist and check out your items, but these are added options for those who prefer it!
