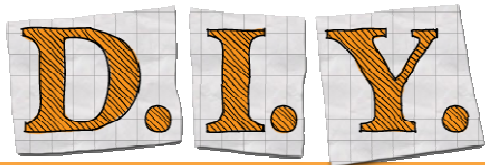

Both databases offer tools to help you cite, print, save, and email your resources.

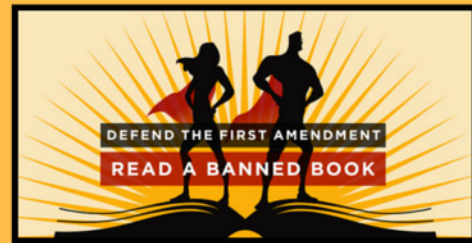
