The Board of Trustees of the Waverly Public Library met in regular session at 5:15 p.m. on Tuesday, July 8, 2008 at the library. Present: Anderson, Biddison, Blake, Main, McCue, Podhajsky, Williams. Meyer-Reyerson was also in attendance. Absent: Timmerman, Waldstein.

- The city will return to its offices at City Hall after the work day on Friday, July 11.
- Sarah Voels, summer library intern from Wartburg, was introduced and welcomed.

Podhajsky moved, Blake seconded the motion that the Board, in appreciation to the staff for their dedicated and consistent work during the flood, will provide treats for the July 18 staff meeting. Main will write a letter of appreciation from the Board.
