- Students spend time with their friends and arrive at school energized and ready to learn!



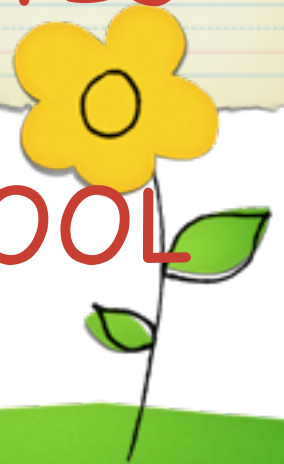

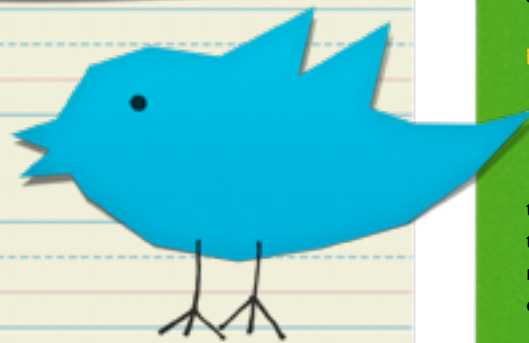

As part of the Southeast Safe Routes to School Campaign, two walking paths from neighborhoods within walking and biking distance to Southeast Elementary have been identified. Maps are available at the school.

Routes identified have been approved by the Waverly Police Department.



Tips for parents who are unsure about letting their children walk to school:

- Walk the identified route for your neighborhood yourself to see first hand the safety of the route.
- Walk with your child to school rather than drive.
- Share the responsibility. Work with other parents in your neighborhood to develop a walking school bus.

FOR STUDENTS WITHIN WALKING DISTANCE

Students are encouraged to walk or bike to school on Fridays, weather permitting. Upon arrival to school, students will receive a punch on their punch card. Once students have collected 10 punches, students will receive a reward. Completed punch cards will be entered in a drawing for the grand prize at the end of the year.

FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE DROPPED OFF OR RIDE THE BUS

Students who ride the bus or are dropped off by parents will be given the opportunity to walk around the playground during the day to receive a punch to their card. Students who collect 10 punches will receive a reward and their card will be entered into a drawing for the grand prize at the end of the year.
