New Hangar Development—Discussion followed lead by Bob and Bob. They will look further into possible corporate interest in building hangars. The airport is trying to increase based aircraft at the airport to raise the Waverly Airport from a Level 3 Airport to a Level 2. This would increase the probability of receiving Federal funding to build the cross-wind runway. The cross-wind runway, which would be wider and longer, would be able to accommodate corporate jets and provide more incentive for businesses to relocate in Waverly. Discussion on preserving the north-south corridor, by purchasing the land with the assistance of the state money that has to be used up next year, followed. Bruce Ecker will call Bill Grabe to incorporate more hangars into the master plan.

Draft FY 2001 Airport Budget—Collins distributed the airport budget. The budget was correct as presented and will be given to the city. There was discussion on why the hangar rent was so high, but this was because the rent would be raised to \$75 on the T-hangars once the new doors are put on.
