Cedar River Park Ball Diamonds – Phase 2

Phase 2 of the Cedar River Park Ball Diamonds project includes field improvements, fencing, final grading and permanent seeding, along with installation of a well and irrigation system. It also includes the construction of building foundations, walkways and parking lots.

Construction is slated to begin in April 2021 and should be completed by September 2021. Watch for construction progress updates at <u>waverlyia.com/leisure-services</u> or <u>facebook.com/CityofWaverlyIA</u>.

Phase 3 of the project could begin in late 2021 and is set to include the construction of facility buildings and an inclusive playground.



1st Street NW Reconstruction



First Street NW will be reconstructed from the south side of 5th Avenue NW to the north side of Bremer Avenue. The project involves replacing the existing multi-layered asphalt pavement with concrete pavement. The reconstruction project is similar to work completed on 10th Street SW in 2020.

The project will take about 12 weeks to complete within the construction window from early May to mid-September. The roadway will be closed but Kohlmann Park will remain open with pedestrian access at Bremer Avenue and 5th Avenue NW.

Public Services Center – North Addition



Construction of the 21,230 square foot addition to the north of the Public Services Administration area at the Public Services Center for Operations & Disaster Response is scheduled to begin in April. The addition will house the Street Division vehicles and equipment which currently occupy building space intended for the Water and Sewer Line Maintenance Divisions.

This project will allow the Water and Sewer Line Maintenance Divisions to consolidate operations and vacate their current locations in the 106-year-old building next to City Hall (as pictured at right) and the equipment storage building at the Wastewater Treatment Facility.

The existing 3,456 square foot Sewer Line Maintenance storage building located on 8th Street SE will be demolished in 2021 to make space for the new wastewater treatment oxidation ditch. The building currently houses the sewer jet truck, portable sewer pumps and other supplies.



Construction of the addition should be complete by the end of the year.

Water, Sewer and Solid Waste Rate Increases

Starting in June 2021 the City of Waverly will implement 0% water and 10% sewer rate increases. The higher sewer rate increase is necessary to cover the cost of the \$11 million Water Pollution Control Facility project that will begin construction in April 2021.

The monthly residential and commercial garbage charges are increasing about 2.5% in July 2021. Rental of the residential recycling containers will be increased 10ϕ per month starting in July 2021. These increases help cover solid waste expenses.

Yard Waste Site

Waverly's Yard Waste Site will open for the 2021 season on March 29th, weather and site conditions permitting. The yard waste processing facility is located north of the Recycling Center at 2800 5th Avenue NW. Leaves, grass clippings, garden waste, and kitchen scraps (no dairy or meat products) are processed into compost. Trees, branches and woody material are shredded into wood mulch. There is no cost to drop off yard waste, and the

There is no cost to drop off yard waste, and the finished products of compost and mulch are free to Waverly residents.

The City will have equipment available to load wood mulch onto pickup trucks or trailers from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. on Fridays.

Compost will not be loaded by the City and must be hand shoveled. See Page 4 for information on having wood mulch and/or compost delivered to your property.

DETAIL INFORMATION ON SPECIAL COLLECTION WEEKS

 Bulky items will be picked up from your curb at the regular landfill charge rate during the week of April 26 – April 30. Residents who want to take advantage of this program will need to pay prior to April 26th at the Public Works office in City Hall (200 1st Street NE) or at Public Services (2900 5th Avenue NW) for each bulky item to be picked up. Only items that are paid for in advance will be picked up. Below is a sample list of bulky items and fees:



Appliances (refrigerator, stove, etc.)	\$ 15.00 each			
TV & Computer Monitor	\$ 12.00 - 22.00 each*			
Furniture, Computer, Printer	\$ 5.00 each			
Gas Grill, Lawn Mower, Bike, etc.	\$ 3.00 each			
Tires (no rims)	\$ 5.00 - 30.00 each*			
Carpeting	\$ 15.00 per cu. yd. (or approx. 300 sq. ft.)

- <u>Yard waste</u> (leaves, grass clippings, and garden waste) is to be placed in biodegradable bags. Bags must be factory labeled as biodegradable or yard waste bags. The biodegradable bags of yard waste will be collected during the 2 weeks of April 26 through May 7. <u>Please have your bags placed at your curb on your garbage day</u>. Biodegradable bags can be purchased at local retail stores. There is no charge for the collection of yard waste during these 2 weeks.
- Brush and sticks must be tied into bundles that are no larger than 4 feet in length, 1½ feet in diameter and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Please have your tied bundles placed at your curb on your scheduled garbage day during the 2 weeks of April 26 through May 7. There is no charge for brush collection during these 2 weeks.
- 4. Your <u>City-owned garbage container</u> is required for garbage that can be collected by the garbage truck on your normal garbage day. Any extra garbage (or overflow) needs a \$2.00 garbage tag per 35-gallon bag and it is to be placed next to your container or if possible, directly on top of your container. Please make sure the garbage tag is visible to the garbage collector.
- 5. <u>No demolition or construction material</u>, such as sheetrock, shingles or wood, will be picked up under this Special Collection Week program. A dumpster can be rented for removal of this material. Call 352-6247 to rent a dumpster.
- 6. <u>Household hazardous materials</u> (oil-based paints, pesticides, garden chemicals, fluorescent tubes, etc.) will <u>not</u> be picked up. Please take these items to the Bremer County Hazardous Waste Site located at 2049 200th Street, Waverly. There is no charge to drop off hazardous material, but Bremer County would like you to call 352-4574 before taking your items to this site. <u>Latex paint is not considered hazardous and therefore is not accepted at the Bremer County Hazardous Waste Site</u>. Latex paint must first be dried. The dried paint and paint containers can then be placed in with your regular garbage. The Home Depot in Waterloo accepts the compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs).
- 7. Check with your pharmacy on properly **disposing of medicines and prescription drugs**. These should not be flushed down the toilet or placed in your garbage.

This spring the City of Waverly is offering the delivery of **wood mulch** and compost for the prices listed below to homes and businesses within City limits. Additionally, the City can load mulch onto private vehicles from 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. on Fridays. The City cannot load compost onto trailers or pickups due to its weight and the potential risk of damaging the customer's vehicle. Compost must be hand shoveled. Call 352-6247 for more information.



<u>Mulch</u>: \$25 for 3 cubic yards <u>Compost</u>: \$25 for 2 cubic yards



<u>Mulch</u>: \$30 for 6 cubic yards <u>Compost</u>: \$30 for 4 cubic yards



<u>Mulch</u>: \$35 for 12 cubic yards <u>Compost</u>: \$35 for 8 cubic yards

♦ One cubic yard of mulch covers an area of approximately 100 square feet at 3 inches thick.

Compost has not been screened and may contain sticks and some foreign debris.
