

Historic District Map

The historic core of the Wartburg College campus is included on the National Register of Historic Places. The dark outline to the right identifies the original 25-acre historic plot.

The plot includes 17 buildings that contribute to the designation and the columns that were salvaged from the original Wartburg Hall. The area is anchored by the Wartburg Chapel and the Science Center along First Avenue NW and extends north through campus, excluding the Ohle Wartburg-Waverly Sports & Wellness Center and Walston-Hoover Stadium, to Fifth Avenue NW. The Manors are included in the designation, but Knights Village is not. The district then runs from the Ubuntu Center on the corner of Fifth Avenue NW and Eighth Street NW back to First Avenue NW.

The Wartburg College district is the fifth in the city. Old Main, on the college's central campus, has been on the historic registry since 1978.
