LEISURE SERVICES FACILITIES COVID-19 UPDATE

In regards to recent mandates from the Federal, State, and local government, we WILL be able to keep the facilities listed below open during these uncertain times.

Currently, the City of Waverly Leisure Services facilities are open or closed as follows:

WAVERLY CITY HALL and CIVIC CENTER closed to the public until further notice. Call 319-352-6263 for immediate Leisure Service and Civic Center needs.

ALL CITY PARKS, THE RAIL TRAIL, AND THE WAVERLY DOG PARK are open as normal. However, public restrooms will remain closed. Playground use is NOT encouraged. City of Waverly staff is NOT sanitizing playground equipment at this time. If utilizing a City Park, we ask that you please practice social distancing and proper personal sanitizing before and after use.

HARLINGTON CEMETERY will be open as normal. Social distancing will be practiced for all burials. Cemetery lot inquiries can be addressed by calling 319-352-6263.


