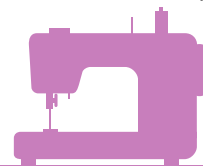


PROJECT RUNWAY

Sunday, Feb. 23, 1-4 PM

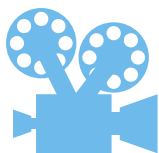

6:30-7:30 PM each time

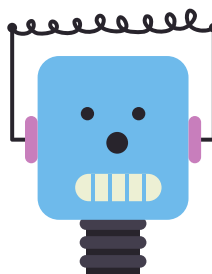

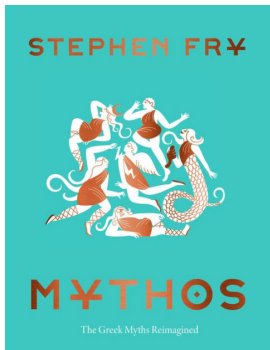
