The Waverly Public Library Board of Trustees met in regular session at 5:15 p.m. on Tuesday, December 14, 2010 in the Waverly Room at the Library.

Meyer-Reyerson demonstrated Bookflix, a new online resource for early readers. The Library has subscribed to this resource at the cost of \$948 per year.

Anderson announced the invitation to the Waverly Area Economic Development breakfast on Friday, December 17 at 7:30 a.m.
